
Dear members and friends,





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The MotherBabylodine project aims to bring attention to the importance of iodine for health, and the extent and consequences of Iodine Deficiency Disorders (IDD) in pregnant women and women of childbearing age (12-50) that continue to affect both developed economies and countries in development.

EUTHYROID2



EUthyroid2 aims to improve low awareness with respect to iodine deficiency and iodine-deficiency disorders (IDD) and highlight the importance of iodine nutrition among the target groups, including adolescents and young adults, the scientific community, medical professionals, and policymakers.

Within EUthyroid2, TFI is responsible for the communication and dissemination of results (WP5). Together with IGN and WIA, TFI aims to raise awareness of iodine deficiency and iodine deficiency disorders (IDD) and the importance of iodine nutrition among the target groups, including adolescents and young women up to age 24 pre-pregnancy, the scientific community, medical professionals, and policymakers and inform the target groups, and other research and health stakeholders about the project's development and achievements.

IODINE COALITION EUROPE



Iodine deficiency in Europe: acting to protect Europe's population from a re-emerging problem. Iodine Coalition Europe is a unique public/private partnership dedicated to ensuring adequate iodine nutrition for Europe's citizens. It includes iodine nutrition experts, representatives of the salt and broader food and iodine industries, and research and patient organizations.
